1. Crop to Hay -- \$290/acre

- ✓ Seed current crop ground OR expiring CRP to hay for <u>5 years</u>
- ✓ Must provide soil test, less than 4 years old
- ✓ One-time payment No acre maximum

2. Summer Fall Grazer -- \$80/acre

- \checkmark Seed current crop ground to multi-year grazing rotation
 - 1. Fall small grain crop
 - 2. Summer fall grazer (summer seeding with fall grazing)
 - 3. Spring cash crop
 - 4. Fall cover crop (additional \$15-35/ac)
- ✓ Extend grazing season
- ✓ One-time payment 40 acre maximum/year

3. Calving Covers/Annual Forages -- \$65/acre

- \checkmark Annual seeding for sacrificial pasture or calving lots
- Ex: Seed covers in spring/summer when livestock go to pasture; graze in fall/winter when livestock return from pasture
- ✓ One-time payment No acre maximum
- 4. Pasture Seeding & Renovations -- Incentive rates vary/acre
 - ✓ Seed crop or CRP to pasture for <u>5 years</u>
